

Brillion Land Use Committee Meeting

LAST PLAN MEETING FOR 2000

On Tuesday, December 5, 2000, the Town of Brillion Land Use Committee convened for a second time since the Comprehensive Planning program “kick-off” in August.

The main objective of the meeting was to discuss the development of a public survey. The purpose of this survey will be to obtain comments from residents on planning and development issues. The survey will include questions to address each of the nine required “smart growth” elements. (For more information about “Smart Growth” please see the **OMNNI Home Page**.)

Jerry Braatz, UW-Extension Agent for Calumet County, directed a discussion to find out what types of questions should be asked in the survey. Land Use Committee Members suggested that questions should address:

- ~~☞~~ Farmland Preservation
- ~~☞~~ Annexation
- ~~☞~~ Park and Trail Development
- ~~☞~~ Groundwater Protection
- ~~☞~~ Telecommunication Towers
- ~~☞~~ Housing

City of Brillion Administrator Dawn Wagner, and City of Brillion Community Development Director, Heather Zander, also attended the meeting. The survey, once finalized, will be incorporated in a “service survey” currently being developed by city staff.

Mr. Braatz will be working with OMNNI Associates to develop a draft survey to present to both the Town of Brillion Land Use Committee and the Brillion City Planning Commission at their first Joint Meeting scheduled for **February 6, 2001 at 7:30pm**. The meeting will be held in the Town of Brillion Hall.

At this point it is anticipated that the planning survey will be distributed in late February or early March of 2001.
