

Town of Brillion Begins Comprehensive Plan

LAND USE COMMITTEE HAS “KICK-OFF” MEETING

On Wednesday, August 16, 2000, the Town of Brillion Land Use Committee convened for the first time to officially start the comprehensive planning process in the town.

The Town of Brillion Comprehensive Plan “Kick-Off” Meeting included a presentation by the Town of Brillion Planning Consultant, OMNNI Associates, summarizing the new “Smart Growth” Legislation (1999 Wisconsin Act 9) and the proposed planning

process in the Town of Brillion. Committee members discussed potential ways to keep the public informed about the planning process. Ideas included: a town newsletter, articles in the Brillion News and postings around Forest Junction. If you have any other ideas, please contact a committee member. Prior to adjournment, the committee selected Mary D. Eickert to serve as Chairperson of the Town of Brillion Land Use Committee.

The next Town of Brillion Land Use Committee will be on **Tuesday, October 17th, 2000 at 7:30pm.** The meeting will be held in the Town of Brillion Hall. The tentative agenda for



the next meeting includes a presentation by OMNNI Associates describing the demographic, housing, and economic characteristics and trends found in the Town of Brillion (including the Forest Junction Area) and a discussion about the 20-year vision for the Town of Brillion.
