

Coordinated Plan Committee Discusses Transportation Element

Tuesday, February 5, 2002. The focus of this month's Coordinated Plan Committee Meeting was transportation. The Smart Growth Comprehensive Planning Law requires that the Transportation Element include a compilation of objectives, policies, goals, maps & programs to guide the future development of the various modes of transportation, including highways, transit, transportation systems for persons with disabilities, bicycles, walking, railroads, air transportation, trucking and water transportation. Using this requirement as a foundation for the transportation planning efforts, OMNNI Associates developed a DRAFT Transportation Element for the committee to consider. (A revised draft will be posted on this web page at a later date, after all areas discussed by the Coordinated Plan Committee have been addressed.)

Prior to the meeting, all members of the Coordinated Plan Committee received a copy of the DRAFT Transportation Element. The DRAFT Transportation Element included five sections:

- The Transportation Vision (as developed by the Committee in 2001)
- An Inventory of Transportation Services and Facilities in the Brillion Community
- Local Transportation Issues & Concerns
- Summary of County, Regional, State and Other Transportation Plans for the Area
- Goals and Objectives

During the meeting, OMNNI Associates led the discussion as the Coordinated Plan Committee reviewed each section of the draft document. During the meeting, the following issues were identified as principal transportation concerns facing the City and Town of Brillion:

- Limited Elderly and Disabled Transportation Choices
- Water Problems Along Center Road
- Status of USH 10 at Minor Arterial and Potential for Increased Future Traffic
- Pedestrian Safety along USH 10 and in Forest Junction
- Safety of the USH 10 and HR Intersection
- Adequate Crossings for Future Recreation Trails at USH 10 and STH 57
- Adequate Highway Funding for Upgrades and Routine Maintenance
- Trail Connections to the Brillion Marsh
- Speed & Safety on Town Roads
- Continuous Road Maintenance Program

The comments of the plan committee will be added to the current draft and forwarded to the City and Town for additional review. Soon thereafter, a revised draft will be posted on this web page for general review.
