

Coordinated Plan Committee Discusses Utilities & Community Facilities Element

Tuesday, June 4, 2002. After a three-month delay in the planning program pending finalization of the Comprehensive Planning Grant Award, the Coordinated Plan Committee jump-started work on the plan again this week.

The focus of this month's Coordinated Plan Committee Meeting was utilities and community facilities. The Smart Growth Comprehensive Planning Law requires the Utilities and Community Facilities Element include a compilation of objectives, policies, goals, maps & programs to address:

- Storm Water Management
- Sanitary Sewer Service
- Water Supply
- Solid Waste Disposal
- On-site Wastewater Treatment Technologies
- Recycling Facilities
- Parks
- Telecommunication Facilities
- Power Plants
- Cemeteries
- Health Care Facilities
- Child Care Facilities
- Police
- Fire and Rescue
- Libraries
- Schools
- Other City/Town Facilities and Services

Using the above list of requirements as a starting point for the planning efforts, OMNNI Associates developed a DRAFT Utilities and Community Facilities Element for the committee to consider. (A revised draft will be posted on this web page at a later date, after all areas discussed by the Coordinated Plan Committee have been addressed.)

Prior to the meeting, all members of the Coordinated Plan Committee were mailed a copy of the DRAFT. The DRAFT Utilities and Community Facilities included six sections:

- The Vision (as developed by the Committee in 2001)
- An Inventory of Utilities and Community Facilities in the Brillion Community
- Local Utilities and Community Issues & Concerns
- Summary of Potential Funding Sources
- Relationship between the Utilities and Community Facilities Element and other required plan elements.
- Goals and Objectives

During the meeting, OMNNI Associates led the discussion as the Coordinated Plan Committee reviewed each section of the DRAFT document. The comments of the plan committee will be added to the current draft and forwarded to the City and Town for additional review. Soon thereafter, a revised draft will be posted on this web page for general review.
