

Coordinated Comprehensive Planning Program

City and Town of Brillion

In order to prepare to meet the challenges and opportunities over the next 20 years, the City and Town of Brillion have hired OMNNI Associates to develop a Coordinated Comprehensive Plan for both communities. Once adopted, the plan will help community leaders make important decisions regarding growth and development issues. Below is a brief summary of what the plan will include and the planning process that will be used.

What will be in the Plan?

The main objective of a Coordinated Comprehensive Plan is to develop a vision for the City and Town of Brillion and recommend those actions that will be needed to achieve it. In this way, the plan should not merely serve as a guide, but should also provide recommendations for tools to implement it (i.e. subdivision ordinance, conservation programs, capital improvement budgeting or economic development projects).

The plan will also include detailed information on the City and Town's:

- *physical features*
- *current and projected land use*
- *housing characteristics*
- *transportation*
- *zoning*
- *current and projected population*
- *economic activity*
- *utilities*
- *implementation measures*

How Long Will It Take to Develop the Plan?

The planning program will be completed over a 36-month period. The Coordinated Comprehensive Plan will be completed in early 2003.

How can the Public Get Involved?

The key to the success of the plan will be the support of local residents. Throughout the

planning program, OMNNI will provide residents of both the City and the Town of Brillion with meaningful information and encourage residents to be actively involved in the planning process.

Public information activities include: a “kick-off” meeting, a “mid-course” meeting, community survey, and a plan presentation meeting. The public is also welcome at the bi-monthly City Planning Commission/Town Land Use Committee Meetings to learn more about the planning process and provide comments and suggestions to committee members.

OMNNI will also provide planning updates for a town newsletter, in the Brillion News and as a link to from this web page.

Who's working on the plan?
