

Town Considers Utilities & Community Facilities Needs for 2025

November 14, 2005. After briefly recapping the Transportation Chapter, Adam Sayre of OMNNI Associates reviewed the draft Utilities and Community Facilities Chapter with the Planning Commission. Like the other element chapters, this chapter begins with a vision for 2025, followed by an inventory of existing conditions, a documentation of utilities and community facilities issues and concerns, and concludes with a series of goals, objectives and policies.

Much of the discussion with respect to the Utilities and Community Facilities Chapter focused on the existing utilities and community facilities. The DRAFT chapter includes a significant amount of information about the location of current parks and the future need for more park space.

During the meeting, OMNNI highlighted some areas where additional information was needed. Participants at the meeting were able to use their local expertise to provide the necessary clarifications.

The next meeting with OMNNI will be on January 9, 2006 in the Town Hall. At this meeting, OMNNI will present the first DRAFT of the Agricultural, Natural and Cultural Resources Element.
