

## Vision Meeting

The Town of Taycheedah Vision Meeting was held on January 18, 2007 at the Taycheedah Town Hall. The objective of the meeting was to have residents identify their *ideal* goals for what they want the community to look and function like in 2026. These goals were to be visionary, while remaining grounded. This was accomplished by the residents completing a series of sentences relating to the various topics listed below.

At the end of the Vision Meeting, residents were given three adhesive yellow dots which they placed next to a vision they felt was particularly important. The number in parenthesis signifies the number of dots placed next to the particular vision (no number signifies no dots). All questions were preceded with the phrase 'In 2026...'
