

Town and Village Review Initial Utilities & Community Facilities Element Draft

Tuesday, January 6, 2004 –The Town of Black Creek Plan Commission and Village Plan Commission met together this month to discuss the Utilities and Community Facilities Element of the Multi-Jurisdictional Smart Growth Plan. Amy Emery of OMNNI Associates facilitated the meeting.

To begin the evening, Ms. Emery led a discussion about the Transportation Chapter related to the north-south railroad corridor and USH 47 bypass. An updated copy of the chapter is posted to this web page that illustrates the current version agreed upon by the Town and Village.

The focus of the meeting was the Utilities and Community Facilities Element. This chapter includes information about schools, the library, Town and Village properties, communication facilities, police protection, fire protection and a host of other topics.

Ms. Emery presented the draft chapter in a page-by-page fashion to introduce everyone to the information. The draft was prepared after conducting interviews with several Town and Village officials and staff. [A copy of this chapter has been posted to this web site under DRAFT PLAN CHAPTERS.](#)
