

Planning Commission Completes Vision Exercise

Thursday, June 27, 2002 –The Town of Center Planning Commission continued its progress on the Town's Smart Growth Comprehensive Plan this month. At the June 27th meeting the Commission:

- ✓ Completed a Vision Exercise
- ✓ Received Land Use Mapping Assignment

Vision Exercise - In April 2002, a vision assignment was distributed to the Planning Commission. (*Copies of this assignment are available in the April 24, 2002 Meeting Summary- [CLICK HERE](#).*) The assignment asked the Commissioners to individually complete a series of sentences describing what they would like to see in the Town of Center in 20 years. For example, the Commissioners were asked to complete the following, "*In the year 2020, looking down from an airplane at the Town of Center one would see...*"

At the June 2002 meeting, the Commissioners worked in 2 groups to review their ideas for each of the statements and arrive at a single best answer for each. These "group answers" were shared with the entire Planning Commission to arrive at a consensus-based answer to each question. OMNNI Associates (the town's planning consultant) will be using these collective responses to draft vision statements that the Planning Commission will review in August 2002.

Mapping Assignment - Prior to adjourning the meeting, the Commission received a Draft Existing Land Use Map. The map was developed using information from the East Central Wisconsin Regional Plan Commission who completed field verifications of land use in March 2002. The Commissioners were asked to review the Draft Map and return a marked-up copy to OMNNI after the July 25, 2002 meeting. OMNNI will make the updates, as requested by the Commission, to accurately reflect existing land use in the town.

The next Smart Growth Meeting with OMNNI is scheduled for August 29, 2002 at 7:00 pm. The Planning Commission meets on the fourth Thursday of every month at 7:00 pm at the Town Hall.
