

Planning Advisory Committee Recommends Plan for Public Hearing

On Wednesday, April 23, at 7:00 p.m., the Town of Oshkosh Comprehensive Planning Advisory Committee convened for their last regular monthly meeting. The purpose of this meeting was to review the final draft of the plan and set the public hearing date.

To begin the meeting, Amy Emery of OMNNI Associates, provided updated copies of each plan chapter to the Committee.

Next, Ms. Emery briefly recapped each chapter. During her presentation, Ms. Emery highlighted some additional minor changes that have been made in recent weeks to reflect Committee comments, Winnebago County Comprehensive Plan efforts, and the requirements of the Smart Growth Law. Copies of the plan maps were also available for the Committee to review with each chapter.

The Planning Advisory Committee suggested a few additional minor changes. During the review, many Committee Members expressed their satisfaction with particular passages, chapters, sections and the general tone of the document. Updated copies of all chapters are posted to this web page.

After completing the review of the plan text, the Planning Advisory Committee Members were given a choice between two different cover designs.

At this point, the Planning Advisory Committee set the **public hearing date for Wednesday, June 18, 2003 at 7:00 pm.**

The rest of the meeting was spent discussing the distribution of the document based on the Smart Growth Law requirements. Copies of the recommended plan will be available at the Office of the Town Clerk and the Oshkosh Public Library.
