

## Committee Hosts First Intergovernmental Meeting

On **Thursday, January 16, at 7:00 p.m.**, the Town of Oshkosh Comprehensive Planning Advisory Committee hosted the first of two Intergovernmental Meetings. At these meetings, the Town of Oshkosh would like to discuss the plans of other local agencies and governments and attempt to coordinate the *Town of Oshkosh Comprehensive Plan* with the goals and objectives of these other local plans. The Town of Oshkosh would also like to identify potential conflicts and develop



strategies to address conflicts that may occur in the future. These collective “meeting of the minds” provide a unique opportunity to discuss area growth, development, transportation, education, and other concerns.

OMNNI Associates helped to facilitate the meeting. Representatives from neighboring communities, school districts, the City of Oshkosh, the East Central Wisconsin Regional Plan Commission, WDNR, and Winnebago County were in attendance.

After welcoming everyone, Committee Chair John Gronlund, turned the meeting over to Bob Stadel and Amy Emery of OMNNI Associates. Amy Emery gave a presentation to summarize the planning activities the Town of Oshkosh has been engaged in since beginning the planning effort in 2000. The presentation concluded with an introduction to the DRAFT Plan Map.

Immediately following the presentation, Mr. Stadel facilitated a discussion with all in attendance to begin to identify potential concerns and questions. The discussion was very productive and several good ideas were raised.

The second intergovernmental meeting is scheduled for February 20, 2003. At that meeting, discussions will continue related to the DRAFT Future Land Use Map. In addition, a DRAFT copy of the Intergovernmental Chapter will be presented and discussed.
