Works to Finalize Future Land Use Maps

On Wednesday, March 19, at 7:00 p.m., the Town of Oshkosh Comprehensive Planning Advisory Committee convened for their regular monthly meeting. This meeting is the last meeting before the Committee is scheduled to finalize the draft (April) and host a public hearing (May).

MEETING DATE CHANGE

The Planning Committee has changed their regular meeting date from the Third Thursday of each month to the Third Wednesday. This change was made to accommodate the Winnebago County Comprehensive Planning Process.

To begin the meeting, Amy Emery of OMNNI Associates, briefly recapped several proposed changes to the Intergovernmental Chapter based on the discussions held at the two Intergovernmental Meetings. The committee also provided some additional changes. An updated copy of the chapter will be posted on this web page to reflect all changes.

Next, Ms. Emery overviewed the Implementation Chapter that was distributed last month. Ms. Emery urged the committee to review the milestone dates presented in this chapter before the April Meeting. A copy of this chapter is posted on this web site.

The rest of the meeting was dedicated to the completion of the Future Land Use Maps. To begin this important task, John Gronlund, facilitated a discussion of the "Talking Points" presented by the City of Oshkosh at the February Intergovernmental Meeting. The City had suggested several changes to the maps that the Town wanted to consider in greater detail.

The entire Planning Advisory Committee collectively reviewed the Future Land Use Map section-by-section. Several changes were noted to reflect anticipated development trends. Ms. Kristi Bales, Principal Planner from the City of Oshkosh, was also in attendance to provide feedback.

Prior to adjourning the meeting, discussion was held regarding the 10-Year Future Land Use Map. The committee suggested several areas be changed to reflect the anticipated timing of development. OMNNI Associates will be updating the Future Land Use Maps and presenting updated copies at the April Planning Advisory Committee Meeting.
