

Committee Receives First Draft of Future Land Use Map

On **Thursday, November 21, at 7:00 p.m.**, the Town of Oshkosh Comprehensive Planning Advisory Committee convened for their regular monthly meeting. The purpose of this meeting was to:

- 1) Review DRAFT Existing Land Use Chapter;
- 2) Review the DRAFT Future Land Use Chapter; and
- 3) Receive the first DRAFT Future Land Use Map

OMNNI Associates facilitated the meeting. Kristi Bales, Principal Planner for the City of Oshkosh, attended on behalf of the City.

To begin the meeting, OMNNI Associates presented a detailed review of the Existing Land Use Chapter. The chapter includes an Existing Land Use Map and the Zoning Map for the Town.

The rest of the meeting was focused on Future Land Use. The Planning Advisory Committee reviewed each section of the **Future Land Use Chapter** in detail. The chapter addresses:

- The Town's Vision for Future Land Use
- Annexation
- Incorporation
- Community Design Considerations (i.e. conservation subdivisions, quarry development, environmental corridors, billboards, etc.)
- A series of supporting goals, objectives and policies

During the review of the chapter, the Advisory Committee offered several suggestions which have been incorporated into the draft posted on this site.

Finally, OMNNI presented the **FIRST DRAFT of the 20-Year Future Land Use Map**. The presentation included a comparison between the 1993 City of Oshkosh Comprehensive Plan Map, the Town's current 10-Year Plan Map and the proposed Smart Growth Map.
