

Village Plan Commission Reviews Sets Public Hearing Date

March 30, 2005. At this meeting, the Village of Slinger Plan Commission reviewed a third and final draft of the *Recommended 2025 Future Land Use Map* along with a draft *Transportation System Plan Map* presented by Amy Emery of OMNNI Associates (the Village's Planning Consultant). Some minor changes were suggested to each map, which will be completed by the Village's mapping consultant.

The first review of the *Recommended 2025 Future Land Use Map* occurred in late 2004. A revised draft was discussed in February, at which time, three changes were suggested, including increasing the mapping area south to CTH E. The third version of the map presented this evening reflected all changes from the first two meetings. In addition, the *Transportation System Plan Map* reflects the anticipated transportation improvements through 2025.

During the meeting Ms. Emery also recapped the Intergovernmental and Implementation Chapters that were distributed at the February meeting to collect any additional changes.

At the conclusion of the meeting the Plan Commission set a public hearing date of May 24, 2005. Prior to the hearing, Village Staff will complete a final review of the plan document. Any changes will be posted to this web site. A copy of the complete plan will be available for review, at least 30 days before the public hearing, at the Village Library and Village Hall.

Copies of the all Draft Plan Chapters are posted to this web site. Once the plan maps are finalized, they will be posted to the web site as well.
